**MAY LAND AUCTION RESULTS**

Land sales are beginning again at Trust Lands. Results were posted for the May 20, 2010, auction. Total revenue was \$209,500. Two trust land properties were offered and sold representing 715.84 total acres. The smaller property of 1.46 acres is located in Montezuma Creek, San Juan County. The other property representing 714.38 acres is located in Box Elder County North West of the Golden Spike National Historic Site.

The Agency is planning on holding another auction in October, 2010. A sales packet with parcel details will be available on the Internet within the next few months.
